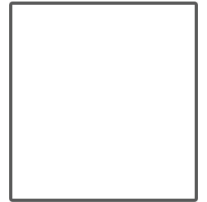

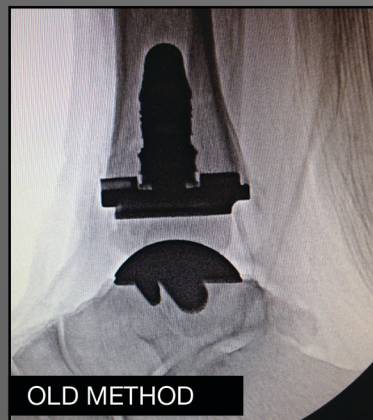

### FOOT AND ANKLE SURGICAL SPECIALIST

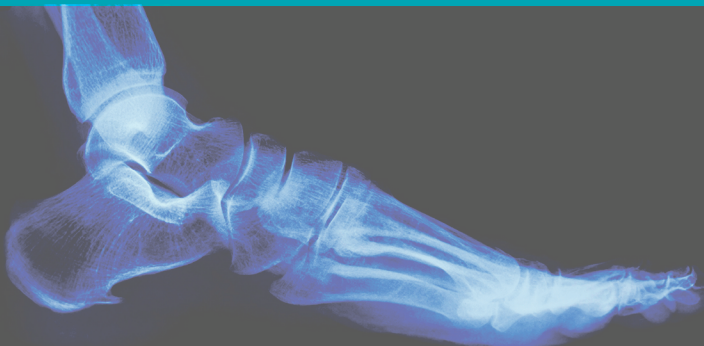

Prior to completing his residency training, Dr. Nowak was one of a select group of residents in the country to be trained and certified in the leading ankle replacement techniques. He is also ABPS Board Qualified in Foot Surgery and Rearfoot/Ankle Reconstructive Surgery.

## A NEW, SMALLER AND MORE EFFECTIVE ANKLE IMPLANT REDUCES OR ELIMINATES ANKLE PAIN AND IMPROVED MOBILITY.

Earlier this year, Dr. Nowak was among some of the first surgeons in the country to adopt usage of the new INFINITY® Total Ankle Replacement (TAR) System. Released in June by the same manufacturer as the INBONE II System, the INFINITY System brings multiple benefits to ankle replacement surgery including:

- less bone resection
- shorter procedure time
- custom CT-guided bone cuts specific to the patients unique anatomy
- less invasive for the surrounding joints (the old implant consisted of drilling across the subtalar joint)
- no anterior tibial cortex violation (less chance of osteolysis, or loosening, around the tibial implant piece) allows for a talar resurfacing option

The new system is compatible with the previous implant and some of the components are interchangeable.

*Dr. Nowak utilizes PROPHECY® Pre-Operative Navigation Alignment technology. PROPHECY technology uses CT scans to create ankle alignment guides unique to each patient. These guides play an important role in the overall success of the ankle replacement procedure because they allow surgeons like Dr. Nowak to properly size, place and align ankle components during the surgery.*
